Abide to the Rules Of Squash as set out by the World Squash Federation (WSF)

All players and associates to abide by the Regulations, Policies and Codes of Conduct as set out by Squash Australia. To view these Regulations, Policies and Codes of Conduct go to the Squash Australia website www.squash.org.au

Play in the Spirit of the Game of Squash and refrain from conduct that would bring the sport into disrepute.

The Player must be a registered and insured member with their State/Territory or Country Association.

All players will be required to mark and referee matches following their match or as directed by tournament officials.

Players 19 years and under MUST wear protective eyewear.

Players MUST report to the control desk 30 minutes prior to their scheduled match time.

The Tournament Director reserves the right to accept or refuse entry, disqualify any player for late arrival or misconduct, alter match times and conditions of play.

Entries will not be accepted unless full entry fee is paid by the close of entries.

Any withdrawal from the tournament after the draw has been finalised will result in the forfeiture of entry monies unless a medical certificate is produced.

The Tournament Organisers (Squash ACT, Woden Squash Centre, Squash Australia and their officers, officials, employees, volunteers or agents) shall not be liable for any death or personal injury, loss of or damage to property sustained or incurred by any person connected with the tournament however caused.

The Tournament Director and Referee 's decision is final.

By signing this entry form I/we accept the conditions of entry under the WSF and Squash Australia Rules of Squash, Regulations, Policies and Codes of Conduct.

I understand that if I breach the conditions of entry it will render me/my child liable for suspension from the tournament.
